Anna Eileen Day, 88, of Bloomington and former longtime Morgan County resident, passed from this life at 8:02 p.m. on Wednesday, March 22, 2017 at the Owen Valley Health Campus. She was born in Morgan County, Indiana, on November 14, 1928 to the late Frank and Agnes (Denney) Sloan.

Eileen, as she was known to friends and co-workers, graduated from Martinsville High School with the class of 1947.
