David L. Wylie, 85, a resident of Bloomington, formerly of Martinsville, passed from his earthly life in the loving arms of his daughter at 7:31 am on Friday, August 9, 2019. He was born on Wednesday, July 11, 1934 in Dolan, Indiana, to the late Archie Lawrence and Ethel (Burris) Wylie.

At the age of five, David and his family relocated to Morgan County. He attended Paragon and Martinsville schools, graduating from Martinsville High School with the class of 1952. On October 2, 1955 David married the love of his life, Harlene Dee (Kinley) Wylie. The two shared over sixty-two years of marriage prior to her death on December 20, 2017. David worked as an estimator and superintendent for Zebrowski & Associates Demolition Contractors in Indianapolis from 1962-1975. After leaving Zebrowski, David changed direction and began a career as an insurance agent and underwriter for Commercial Union Insurance Company, also in Indianapolis. He was a steadfast employee, retiring in 1999 after nearly 25 years.

He was a former member of the Masonic Lodge #74 F & AM and a longtime member of the First United Methodist Church in Martinsville. Most recently, he had attended River Valley Christian Church in Martinsville. David had a passion for model trains, he loved to 'tinker', follow politics, and read. He once said, "I'm a busy man with nothing to do." Above all, David was a proud and loving husband and father who loved to spend time with his family and take Sunday drives through the countryside.

He will be missed deeply by his daughter, who lovingly called him "Daddy", Debra Kay Wylie of Bloomington, IN; brother, Bob Phillips of Plainfield, IN; and sister, Marjorie Forsythe of Crown Point, IN.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Harlene; brother, Paul Wylie and sister, Betty Parker.
